

Important! Deleting data from the display is permanent; there is no 'undo' so make sure to save any information that's important before deleting!!

Check Storage Hours Remaining:



When the main screen is displayed press the I button on the top of the display. A pop-up screen will appear and the hours of remaining storage displays at the bottom. To confirm that data is being deleted, check the remaining storage hours before and after deletion operations.

Deleting Coverage



Coverage logging is the yellow that displays on the guidance screen during application. Deleting coverage does not delete fields.

1. From the main guidance screen, select  and press . The *Configuration* screen appears.


2. Select *Configuration / Data Management / Manage Fields / Delete Coverage Logging*.

3. Select the *Client, Farm, Field* and/or *Event*. Coverage files can be deleted for each level individually, or by *Client, Farm, Field* or *All*. To select *All* press  until the *Client* line is highlighted and press . The *Client* screen appears.



4. Press  until *All* is highlighted and press . The *Delete Coverage Logging* screen appears again. Notice that *Client* now specifies *All* and there are no other choices on the *Farm, Field* or *Event* lines. This will delete all coverage data regardless of which *Client, Farm* or *Field* they are in. The *All* choice is available at each *Client, Farm* or *Field* level.

5. Select *Delete Files* and press . A warning message appears.

6. Press  to continue. A screen may appear to warning that the operation could take some time. Do not disconnect power during this process.








7. The *Delete Coverage Logging* screen appears explaining that the deletion was successful.

Deleting Fields

Delete Fields when the wrong *Client, Farm* and/or *Field* names are entered or the field information isn't needed.









1. From the main guidance screen, select  and press . The *Configuration* screen appears.

2. Select *Configuration / Data Management / Manage Fields / Delete Selected Fields*.

- Select the *Client, Farm, Field* and/or *Event*. Fields can be deleted for each level individually, or by *Client, Farm, Field* or *All*. To select *All* press  until the *Client* line is highlighted and press . The *Client* screen appears.
 - Press  until *All* is highlighted and press . The *Delete Coverage Logging* screen appears again. Notice that *Client* now specifies *All* and there are no other choices on the *Farm, Field* or *Event* lines. This will delete all fields regardless of which *Client, Farm* or *Field* they are in. The *All* choice is available at each *Client, Farm* or *Field* level. Remember that deleting is irreversible.
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- Select *Delete Files* and press . A warning message appears.
 - Press  to continue. A screen may appear to warning that the operation could take some time. Do not disconnect power during this process.
 - The *Delete Fields* screen appears explaining that the deletion was successful.

Deleting Summary Reports

Deleting Summary Reports has no effect on the *Client, Farm, Field* and *Events* or on the coverage logging. These are reports that have been created by the EZ-Guide 500/250 using the CFFE and coverage data.

- From the main guidance screen, select  and press . The *Configuration* screen appears.
- Select *Configuration / Data Management / Summary Reports / Delete Summary Reports*.
- Select the *Client, Farm, Field* and/or *Event*. Summary reports can be deleted for each level individually, or by *Client, Farm, Field* or *All*. To select *All* press  until the *Client* line is highlighted and press . The *Client* screen appears.
- Press  until *All* is highlighted and press . The *Delete Coverage Logging* screen appears again. Notice that *Client* now specifies *All* and there are no other choices on the *Farm, Field* or *Event* lines. This will delete all summary reports regardless of which *Client, Farm* or *Field* they are in. The *All* choice is available at each *Client, Farm* or *Field* level. Remember that deleting is irreversible.
- Select *Delete Files* and press . A warning message appears.
- Press  to continue. A screen may appear to warning that the operation could take some time. Do not disconnect power during this process.
- The *Delete Summary Reports* screen appears explaining that the deletion was successful.
